Exercise no. 12. "Career development plan: what are you going to do"

Task for mentee:

There are some questions and possible answers below. Please answer the following questions by choosing one of the answers. Choose the answer (A, B or C,) that is right for you and mark your selection.

What are you going to do in these situations?	Choose the answer (A, B or C) that is right for you.
1. You are about to graduate. Everyone is asking you what are you going to do after graduation and you do not know. What are you going to do?	A. You are going to wait till you will know the results of your exams. B. You are going to meet a career consultant in order to plan your career. C. You will do the same as your friends will because you think that they know better.
2. During the consultation with career consultant, he/she suggests you to find out more about the employment possibilities that you are interested in. What are you going to do?	A. You will ask your friends what they know about these employment possibilities. B. You would like to find out more about that, but you will not do anything for this purpose. C. You will go to the library or will search for the information in the internet as soon as possible.
3. You have heard that you can practice your profession via work related practise programmes.	A. You will not try to find out anything about these programs, because you think that these programs are not useful. B. You think that it is a good idea, but you would rather find a paid job. C. You will analyse the booklet that you have got from your career consultant and you will write an e-mail asking for more information.
4. You entered the studies/ courses but the speciality appeared to be not what you had expected.	A. You will give up your studies because you think that it is not worth studying. B. You will discuss that with your friends. C. You will talk with your career consultant and discuss the other possibilities.

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5. You think that you will not pass the exams because you are not a successful learner. What are you going to do?	A. You stop attending the courses that you are not successful at. B. You will talk with the lecturer and ask for advice. C. You will work hard on the courses that you are not successful at in order to succeed.
6. You find a suitable job offer at the local career centre. It asks for CV. But your CV is poor and you don't know how to improve it. What are you going to do?	A. You are going to visit employer, suggesting him/her to talk with you, as your CV is poor and you don't know how to improve it. B. You will ask the career consultant to help you re/write the CV and send it. C. You are not going to send your CV and participate in the recruitment.
